Visitors to DEA

- Q: What is the process for scheduling a visit to campus if I would like to meet with people in DEA?
- **A:** The recommended steps to follow are:
 - 1. If you are visiting as a prospective student, contact the Director of Graduate Studies(DGS), Nancy Wells, at nmw2@cornell.edu or 607-254-6330 to set up a date and time to visit.
 - Once you secure a date/time with Nancy or DGS, check the DEA people web site page at: http://www.human.cornell.edu/dea/people/index.cfm to see it here are any other faculty/staff members you would like to meet with, and contact them for their availability on the chosen dates.
 - Optional schedule a walking tour of campus: http://www.cornell.edu/visiting/ithaca/walking_tours.cfm

- Q: What are transportation options for getting to Ithaca?
- A: There are several options. Tompkins County Airport is 10 minutes from campus and is served by several airlines. Syracuse airport is approximately 1 ¼ hour from Ithaca. From NYC, there is a *Campus-to-Campus* bus service http://www.transportation.cornell.edu/coach/. Amtrak also serves Syracuse.
